kurt vonnegut is either the funniest serious writer around or the most serious funny writer los angeles times book review in this self portrait by an american genius kurt vonnegut writes with beguiling wit and poignant wisdom about his favorite comedians country music a dead friend a dead marriage and various cockamamie aspects of his all too human journey through life this is a work that resonates with vonnegut s singular voice the magic sound of a born storyteller mesmerizing us with truth vonnegut is at the top of his form and it is wonderful newsday

an autobiographical collage from the renowned novelist includes previously unpublished articles essays letters drawings songs and talks in which vonnegut reflects on his life and times

in this revealing collection of essays vonnegut examines the issues and

kurt vonnegut presents in *fates worse than death* a veritable cornucopia of vonnegut's thought on what could best be summed up as perhaps anti theology a manifesto for atheism that details vonnegut's drift from conventional religion even a tract evidencing belief in the divine held within each individual self the deity within each individual person present in a universe that otherwise lacks any real order vonnegut was never a real optimist and with just cause he had an incredibly difficult life he had been a prisoner of war from which he drew the title for his book *slaughterhouse five* and suffered from failing health which only showed him his own mortality even more than he already knew it still most readers find that in the body of vonnegut's work there is still a glimmer of desperate hope vonnegut's continued search for meaning surely counts for a great deal as he balances hope and despair scholars and fans can read about vonnegut's experiences during world war ii and the after effect he felt it had on him his religious or anti religious ramblings and notations are interesting and by turns funny and perceptive the humor may be dark but that does not make it any the less funny provided by publisher

a memoir spanning lyric essay childhood games assemblage and traditional poetic form *tears bra and all* tells a story of refashioning how is memory a material can something deemed trash be meaningful and made anew the book opens with a stalking the constant rattle of a doorknob haunts annastacia as she tries to move on after her university's failure and refusal to protect her stegall reconfigures this memory its aftermath and other violences into new forms for readers to write on cut fold and play with poems materialize as cootie catchers games of m a s h and more as she revisits past events with a louder voice she adds this voice to a chorus in the book's final section documenting the sewing of a corset from other people's trash that invokes the found object art and history of baroness elsa von freytag loringhoven stegall's writing vibrates with rage and lingers in patches of sunlight it summons ancient tragedies converses with avant garde artists and poets and takes careful note of outfits tears bra and all is an extraordinary work of autobiographical collage that gives readers a participatory role and trash a more expansive meaning
